



Daily Harness Inspection Procedure

To be visually inspected before use. Check to be performed by the user:

HARNESS, SHOCK ABSORBER, LANYARDS AND HOOKS:

- 1. Check that harness label clearly displays SABS certification mark and harness registration number.**
- 2. All stitch-blocks to be checked for damaged stitching.**
- 3. Check for damage to edge of harness and lanyard webbing, or holing or excessive abrasion of harness and lanyard webbing.**
- 4. Check all harness buckles for distortion.**
- 5. Check double action hook mechanisms working freely.**
- 6. Check that shock absorber cover is intact.**

If after conducting this simple visual check, the user is in any doubt that the product is fit for use, according to the above checklist, the product should immediately be replaced/withdrawn from service and forwarded to the responsible person or SpiderWebb Safety Systems (Pty) Ltd for a comprehensive inspection.
